Thank you for praying with us. The format of our prayer bulletin has changed in an effort to provide you with more detail on the specific needs of the ministry at FBH International and our worldwide partners. We invite you to join us in lifting up the following needs before our Lord.

**Sunday** — **FBH International** – Due to a combination of existing commitments to other ministries, his family, and local assembly, Bobby Halek has resigned from his position with FBH.

- Ron Hughes will remain FBH president in the interim.
- For Deborah, Stephen and Ron, to be able to adjust to the smaller workforce without added strain.
- For the board of directors as they develop a new transition plan.
- That during this time we would not experience a decline in support for the work.
- For the Lord to direct us to the person He is preparing to join the ministry team.

**Monday** — **Arab World Media** – In our correspondence with Arab World Media last month, we learned of the work going on in Al Ain, a city in Abu Dhabi.

- Conversion to Christianity in the city is illegal, and can carry serious consequences.
- The large number of foreign workers creates various cultural and language barriers.
- AWM workers are all expat professionals, balancing busy full time jobs with ministry work.
- Evangelists are seeking to meet people through their work and build relationships.

**Tuesday** — **FEBC Russia** – Reports from FEBC Russia show that over a million people were listening to their New Year broadcast across the country, and many responded to what they heard.

- One responder revealed she had been struggling with suicidal thoughts, and asked for prayer.
- Another responder, Tatyana, said she has been dealing with the deep pain of losing a young child.
- Tatyana is still in touch with FEBC, and has started attending church for the first time in her life.
- The FEBC staff continues to minister to both women, encouraging them to trust God for help.

**Wednesday** — **HopeStreamRadio** – We have been working through a number of administrative details at HopeStreamRadio in the recent weeks, as we look to expand the ministry.

- Our new website, designed to make the content more accessible, is close to completion.
- Updates to our mobile apps, with many new features have been released.
- We are talking with new producers who have expressed interest in creating content for us.
- Pray that God will use these new developments to help us reach more of His people.

**Thursday** — **Fish Studios** – In February, Nathan had the opportunity to respond to a request to have him travel to Lima, Peru, for the purpose of helping a believer in Christ launch a new radio station.

- He was able to share his knowledge and expertise in designing a new recording studio.
- This may open a new door for our Spanish language program to be aired in Lima.
- He connected with station managers from other areas of the country, already airing his programs.
- Nathan is back in Mexico City, and continues to work on Spanish programming for FBH.

**Friday** — **Ministry Worker** – Adel is a part of the Arab World Media response team, and one of three workers who are directly supported by FBH International.

- Adel's work involves making personal contact with people in predominantly Muslim countries.
- People who make contact are seeking to know more about Jesus.
- Often contact is made by phone or social media outlets, but sometimes he will meet in person.
- With the great opportunity to share the Gospel, there is a very real personal risk due to the culture.
- Adel also engages new believers to disciple them, and help them find a local gathering.

**Saturday** — **FEBC Ukraine** – Late last year, martial law was declared in the areas of Eastern Ukraine that were under rebel control. Along with this, all evangelical churches in these regions were outlawed.

- God provided an opportunity for FEBC to place new radio towers in strategic locations in the area.
- The entire city of Donetsk, controlled by the rebels, is now hearing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Martial law has been lifted now, but the church is still under severe persecution in the area.
- There are thousands of listeners in Donetsk, who are hungry for the truth.
- The region continues to be plagued by violence from the conflict with Russia.
